


Let's Get Started

Use Any Scripture You Choose



Leave enough space between each word so that the children can cover it with their craft sticks Create a Scripture Page

Create 1 Set of Verse Sticks Per Child (If you have 20 children, you will need 20 sets)

Write the word on one end of the stick. Make it large enough to read but not so large that it takes up more than 1/2 of the stick.

Set up!

1. Place all the sticks into a bucket, basket, cup, bowl, etc.


Hint: Don't use a clear

2. Pass out one scripture sheet to each child. 3. Have the children sit on the floor in a circle


3. Hand the die to the first person.

Rules:

- 1. The first child will roll the die in an attempt to roll a 1 or a 6.
- 2. If the child rolls a 1 or a 6, they can reach into the basket and choose a stick. (don't let them look).
- 3. The child will place the stick they chose on their scripture page...covering the same word as on the stick.
- 4. The entire group will then recite the entire scripture out loud...emphasizing the word covered by the stick.
- 5. The die is then passed to the next person.
- 6. If the child does not roll a 1 or a 6, the die is passed on to the next person.
- 7. Play continues until all scripture pages are covered with the sticks.



Reinforce the Verse



1. Have the class whisper the scripture verse

2. Have the class yell the scripture verse

3. Have the class whisper some of the words and yell out different words

4. Have the class turn their papers over and recite the verse from memory.

REPETITION IS ONE OF THE GREATEST VERSE MEMORIZATION TOOLS!




When creating your scripture sticks, write the words using a red marker. When you are ready to learn a new verse, flip the stick over and write the new scripture words on the back side of the stick using a blue marker. You can choose to use the red set or the blue set ... getting two games out of the same set of sticks.







Reinforce the Verse



REPETITION IS ONE OF THE GREATEST VERSE MEMORIZATION TOOLS! When all the children have finished their pages, have them repeat the verse again...

Switch it up!
